PLANTATION PROGRAM

In our College, Eco club is very active. Eco club in co-ordination with NCC, NSS and Staff actively participates in the Plantation program. Every year it is our practice to increase the Plantation cover. Apart from increasing the plantation cover we also concentrate on the protection of Plants and see that each Plant survives the harsh climatic conditions of this area. The rocky red soil in the College is not suitable for the luxurious growth of the Plant. These plants have to survive the harsh dry summer season. So regular watering of the Plants is the need of the hour. The Staff along with the students of the College are very actively engaged in Planting, watering and gardening activities.

Apart from plantation, we see that the bio-diversity of the College premises also to increase. This is possible by planting new varieties in our garden and College premises. Trees, shrubs and herbs are more or less equally represented in our College. In our college we have small Garden protected by the fencing. For increased Plantation and creating the eco-friendly area, demands more area to be brought under the protected garden. So by the next Academic year we are planning to expand our protected green cover by creating the new garden area in the college premises. More plants create more Organic waste. We wish to convert this Organic waste in to Vermi-compost and recycle the minerals for the luxurious growth of the Plants. This Vermi-compost unit, which we are planning to set up in our garden area in the next Academic year will definitely help in solid Waste management and keep our campus eco-friendly. In addition to this we are also planning to establish an Azolla pond in the new garden area. Depending upon the funds available in the next academic year we are also planning to setup a Hydroponics unit in our Botany lab.

We procure the Plants from Forest department and Nurseries for Plantation purpose. Even though the Plantation is a continuous practice, we take up this activity vigorously during the rainy season for the better survival of the Plants. We are very fortunate to have actively engaged Staff members who are not only engaged in Plantation program but also finance to purchase the Plants from Nurseries. The efforts put by our students in plantation are laudable.
