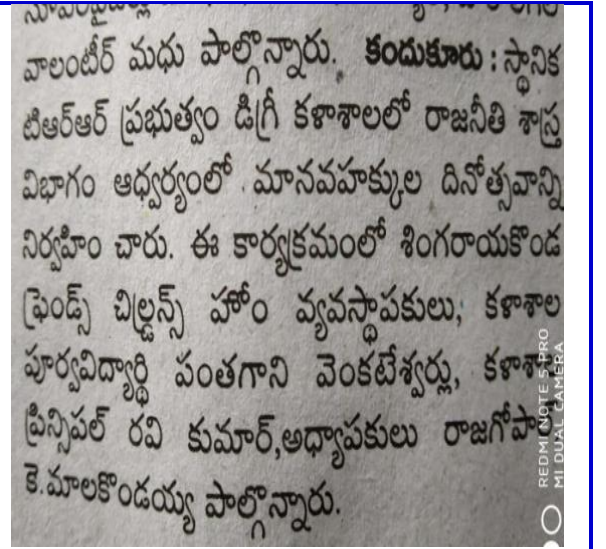

RANGOLI COMPETITION

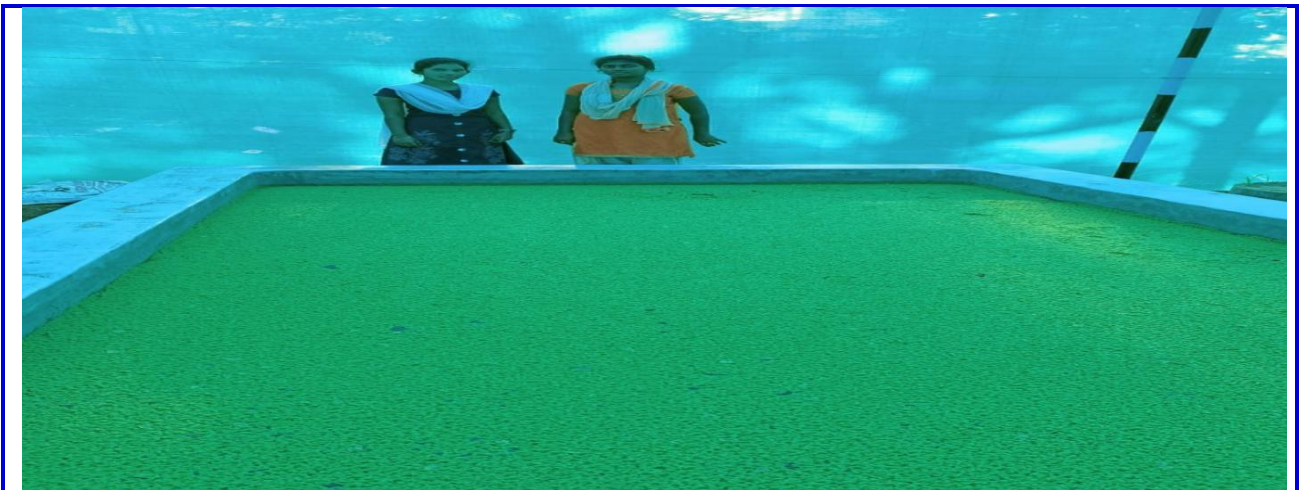

AZOLLA CULTURE

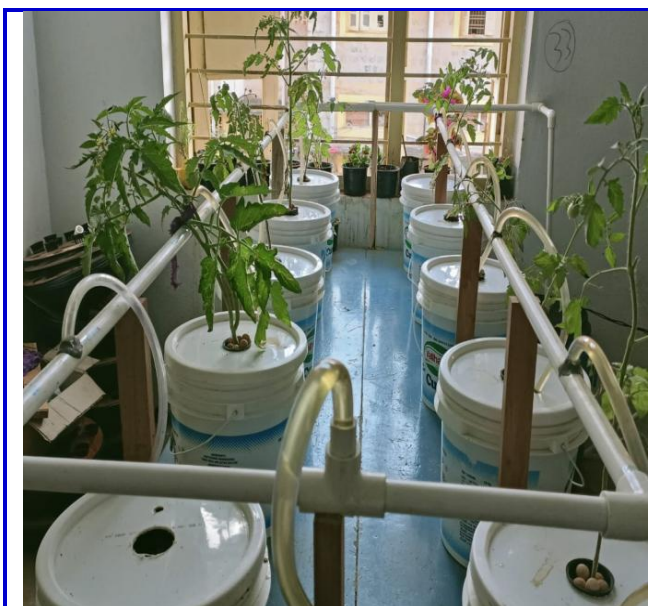
Botany Department constructed an Azolla Pond and brought it under maintenance with the help of students who are studying BZC. Students completed the work of Azolla Pond on 16th February 2020. They have developed the Azolla Pond by mixing the fertile soil with cow dung and water, then spreading across uniformly over the pond.

Azolla pond will be a great source of food for the aquatic animals including fish, birds and aquatic life. Azolla takes up nutrients from the water. From this project T.R.R Govt Degree college students proved they are not only meant to excel in theory part but also in practical manner which will be useful for the nature.



HYDROPONICS UNITS

Hydroponics is a type of Horticulture and a subset of hydro culture which involves growing plants, usually crops without soil by using water based mineral nutrient solutions in aqueous solvents.
